#### **Title of the Practice**

#### A. Social Responsibility, Helping and Altruism

#### **Objectives**

- To develop consciousness about human values among students
- To strengthen social bondage with service to the community
- To make students establish empathy through gratitude

#### Context

Many students hail from rural or semi-urban background, and are aware of the plight of poverty and lack of access to resources. Challenging situations like another wave of COVID Pandemic move them emotionally creating an urge to help those in need and distress.

#### **The Practice**

The students of Hamidia are inspired by real life opportunities to experience the value of helping others. By practicing altruism, kindness, compassion, gratitude, empathy and many other positive qualities emerge. Hamidian students learn that helping others is also a great way to help themselves. Altruistic activities were conducted in adopted villages by the students where they checked oxygen levels of villagers, distributed face masks, demonstrated proper handwashing techniques, especially among the youth and children. Young champions stepped up as communicators on the frontline, promoting health and safety. They took concrete efforts to reduce adverse impact of the second wave of the pandemic. While spreading goodwill, they also led the drive through heroic acts of courage and supported families and neighbouring communities.

The focus of students was on old people and people suffering from medical conditions and ailments. To prevent transmission of Corona, they advised and pursued villagers, to stay home when they are sick, practice social distancing, use masks distributed by them. The statistics shared by them to community certainly helped to lessen dread and apprehension and manage the situation in a healthier way. Counselling with the help of psychology teachers, they helped the community, also advising them to be vigilant against spread of rumours, sensitive messages or incorrect information on social media. They visited municipal wards near the College and govt. hospitals to spread awareness.

#### Activities conducted -

- 15/01/22 Students and faculty distributing blankets and woollen clothes to villagers at Gram Panchayat Hinauti, Adopted village.
- 25/02/22 Health Check-up Camp organised for villagers in Hinauti Sadak. Students went from door-to-door spreading message of health awareness, protecting from corona, getting check-ups done, etc.
- 27/07/2022 Health Check-up Campaign for faculty and students in college campus.
- Altruistic activities conducted in the adopted villages of Kodiya, Bhoyipura basti.
- 01/01/2022 Distribution of woollen clothes and blankets in village Rasuliya Ghat, panchayat Kodia by the teachers, students and NSS volunteers.
- 09/08/22 Establishing sense of national pride among villagers. NSS students of Hamidia College hoisted National Flag under Ghar Ghar Tiranga initiative. They forwarded the spirit of Har Ghar Tiranga programmes at the adopted village Kodiya.
- Nurture nature do not litter Students of Hamidia took social responsibility of cleaning neighbouring village Hinauti. They showed great pride in their community and in beautifying the area.

- Keep Hamidia and neighbouring village tidy! The list of social problems caused by litter and trash is extensive. Litter creates safety, fire, and a variety of human health hazards because of the organisms attracted to it (bacteria, rats, roaches, and mosquitoes).
- 01/07/22 Smart City Tree Plantation The students of Hamidia in Clean City Green City drive called by the Chief Minister, Madhya Pradesh participated in Tree plantation.
- 17/07/22 Youth Panchayat On the occasion of 116th Anniversary of Shaheed Chandrashekhar Azad, students participated in first screening phase of youth conclave and expressed their views through various activities like sports, start up, My Madhya Pradesh My Pride, environment conservation. This activity enhanced leadership traits in youth and exposed them to various opportunities for career.
- Covid Vaccination Camp Under the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsava, the students of Hamidia organised Covid Vaccination camp for precautionary vaccine dose.
- Money Donation was done by student as well as teachers during pandemic to help people in the society, especially from lower income groups. Cooked food and raw grains were distributed during door-to-door surveys.
- Blood Donation A blood donor is equal to a lifesaver -
  - 01/10/2021 and 24/04/2022. Under the aegis of Amrit Mahotsava, the students of Hamidia donated blood. Student volunteers also motivated others for donating blood to save life. The students were given certificates and mementos by the officer-in-charge.
  - 550 units of blood was donated in a single day by students of Hamidia.

- The students organised Blood Donation Camp and communitylevel Cleanliness Drive to mark the Human Unity Day, i.e., Manav Ekta Diwas on April 24th on the anniversary of the sacrifice by Baba Gurbachan Singh Ji for the entire Humanity.
- In a programme organized by Lions Club Bhopal, students of Hamidia celebrated National Voluntary Blood Donation Day on 1st of October 2021 to spread awareness about and share views on the need and importance of donated blood in the life of an individual.

#### - Swachchta Abhiyan

- Slogan writing competition was organised by the college. The topic for slogan writing was 'Role of Youth and Cleanliness.'
- To spread the message of clean and green campus, the students did Shramdaan

#### - Drug Free Campaign –

- Health is Wealth, with this motto, students spread awareness through Nukkad Natak about the ill effects of Tobacco on 'World No Tobacco Day'. In beyond-the-campus drive they played Nukkad Natak in the adopted neighbourhood Bhoyipura. Here they also checked oxygen levels of villagers, distributed face masks, demonstrated proper handwashing techniques.
- Under Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyan, a Six Days Programme was organised for spreading awareness for a Nasha Mukt society.
- Sri Tarun Bamba from UNDP gave a presentation before students and the college faculty on the side effects of drug abuse.
- The director of Social Justice and Public Welfare, Dr R K Singh asked the students to take pledge against drugs and also to spread awareness in this direction. He emphasised that in order to achieve a drug-free society, awareness has to start at the level of young students.

#### - Steet Play On Effects Of Tobacco Consumption On Oral Health

- 30th May 2021: The students of Hamidia took up social responsibility of spreading awareness about ill effects of chewing tobacco and smoking. The volunteers took a pledge against tobacco. An awareness rally was taken up to the adopted village Bhoyipura. A street play was also enacted focussed on harmful impact of tobacco on health.
- Plantation Drive
  - 01/07/2022 Chief Minister Sri Shivraj Singh Chauhan planed samplings of Ficus, Neem and Karanj in Smart City Park with students of Hamidia College.
  - CM motivated the student to be actively involved in saving trees and protecting environment.
  - The CM also felicitated the students with mementos. The faculty of Hamidia, students, Bhopal Collector Avinash Lavania and CEO Smart City Ankit Asthana were also present.

#### - Socially concerned and connected

• Street vending is an integral part of the economic growth process in a city. On account of being unorganized and self-employed, vendors often lack in establishing any linkage with social security, welfare, and assistance schemes. This makes street vendors and their families susceptible in difficult times. The National Urban Livelihood Mission seeks to address the concerns of urban street vendors by facilitating access to suitable spaces for vending, institutional credit, improved skills and social security linkages.

• Hamidia students carried out socio economic survey of street vendors under National Urban Livelihood Mission under the aegis of Nagar Nigam Bhopal. The students addressed the vulnerabilities of the urban street vendors through this survey paving way for issuance of identity cards to them. They retrieved information from vendors and their families, compiled it, completed the task of identification of beneficiaries, enlisted it and uploaded online on the portal. A data base of vendors is thus available with authorities and urban poor and homeless see a ray of hope for their betterment.

#### **Evidence of Success**

- Students of Hamidia were able to assure and convince people regarding need and necessity of Covid vaccination.
- Through cleanliness drives students did make a mark in the city; thus they were awarded by Municipal Corporation, Bhopal.
- Covid vaccination camps were organised in adopted villages.
- Swachchta Abhiyan both in the campus and beyond campus was successful.

#### **Problems Encountered and Resources Required**

- Challenges related to pandemic: it was not easy for students to convince villagers, especially senior citizens for taking precautionary vaccination dose.
- Limitation of direct contact with people
- Changes in active lifestyle
- fear of contracting infection, insecurity and uncertainty about the future

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#### **Notes (Optional)**

- Altruistic works carried out by students, especially in adopted villages and city urban areas gave altogether a new experience to boys, who felt a sense of completeness in their own personality and found great pride in this role. The response in the form of praise and appreciation from the community they helped was a morale booster for students who found a self-less zeal in extending their work in other areas and motivating fellow students. Awards and accolades they got from govt functionaries was an added feather in the cap which they will always cherish in life.

- In their feedback and post-activity discussion with the faculty, the students' changed perception about life and social commitment could be felt.

### **Title of the Practice**

### B. <u>Blended Mode of Teaching and Learning with Flipped</u> <u>classes</u>

### **Objectives**

- To provide benefits and advantages of both e-learning and conventional classroom learning to students.
- To makes it easier and more convenient for learners to access information outside the classroom.
- To enhance learning in post-online face-to-face sessions through better interactions with instructors and peers.
- To obtain instant feedback in online assessment, and quickly incorporate required modifications.
- To create interactive community of online learners.
- To shift from traditional offline mode to blended learning mode that accomplishes the NEP 2020 mandates and benchmarks.

### The Context

Blended Mode of Teaching and Learning with Flipped classes meets the principle of New Education Policy which lays emphasis on broad use of technology in teaching and learning, eliminating language barriers, boosting access as well as education planning and management. Thus, the need for initiatives to introduce timely changes in compliance with the new policy. It combines both face-to-face and online communication, using additional online resources.

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It gives more space for students' creativity and allows to dive deeper into subjects. In post pandemic scenario, teachers and students already friendly with the mode find it easier and compatible. Tools like Google Meet, Microsoft Teams and Google Classrooms are used to conduct classes. Practical sessions were also conducted online where students submitted files through email. The students were provided with e content, links for study material, discussion on relevant core areas while offline sessions focussed on special needs of learners, especially slow learners.

#### **The Practice**

- 19 professors from the college were facilitators and subject experts to draft the syllabus as per the NEP guidelines. All meetings were conducted online, and e syllabus was prepared. Chairman and Members Board of Studies drafted the new syllabi as per the NEP (New Education Policy).
- Students participated in class discussions in online mode. Notes for the students were shared online by the faculty. Links for extended learning were shared.
- Video lessons and web content in addition to regular classes were shared to improve learning and in turn to enhance skills.

- Teaching faculty participated in Faculty Development Programmes, webinars, and online conferences to excel in flipped classes, being comfortable with e-tools of teaching. Live interaction in Distance mode was innovative for students, it made the classes remarkably interesting.
- College organized many online skill development programmes and trainings for the students.
- Swami Vivekanand Career and Placement Cell gave online sessions on personality development, communication skills, and behavioural skills.
- A number of ICT tools were effectively used to enhance and optimize active learning. All the departments used diverse sets of ICT tools to communicate, create and disseminate knowledge, like PowerPoint presentations, departmental blogs, graphs, e-notes.
- The College has smart classrooms; network resource centre and virtual class which facilitate use of ICT enabled tools for enhancing teaching learning process. The Network Resource Centre has been immensely instrumental in broadening the learning spectrum of students.

### **Activities conducted**

06/09/2021 - Webinar on **Prospects Of Self Employment** - Opportunities discussed to become a freelancer, event manager, real estate manager, sole proprietorship, consultancy programming, marketing etc.

13.10.2021 – 'Mantra of Success' programme: The students of Hamidia interacted online with Civil Services candidates and successful participants of competitive exams under the aegis of *Aazadi ka Amrit Mahotsava*. Hon. CM Shri Shivraj Singh Chouhan launched the programme. Shri Mohan Yadav, Minister of Higher Education addressed the students.

23/03/22 - Expert lecture on 'Skill of Assertion'. Resource Person Dr Nidhi Tiwari, Professor, Regional Institute of Education. The session was presented online with power point presentation.

Several rounds of online meeting of Principal, IQAC Coordinator and members IQAC with State NAAC Cell were conducted.

18/02/2022 - As part of NEP agenda, Dr Diwa Mishra addressed the students and faculty to familiarize them with e text, PPTs, quiz and videos to improve quality, skill development, other modern technology.

06/10/2022 - Online learning through Swayam Portal. Dr R K Vijayvargiya completed one-day faculty enrichment programme on Swayam portal.

22/02/2022 - IPR Awareness and Training Programme was held under the aegis of IPO Mumbai organised by Swami Vivekanand Career Guidance Cell.

19/02/2022 to 26/03/2022 - Literary Fest organised by Department of English. 05 Activities were conducted in Blended mode, 'Let Nature Be Your Teacher', 'All the World's a Stage' and 'The Wings of Imagination' were conducted with PPTs in offline Mode. Peer teaching and participatory learning were conducted on Google Meet.

- 16<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> March 2022 Literary Fest in blended mode.
- *All the World's a Stage* Session with PPT on Macbeth, a tragedy by William Shakespeare.
- 16/03/2022 *Wings of Imagination* Poetry recital, English and in regional translation.
- 12/03/2022 Online peer teaching conducted by students of PG English.
- 17/08/2022 District level Essay Competition, organised by Hindi Granth Academy and Swami Vivekanand Career and Guidance Cell.

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#### Outcome

The new NEP clearly states that it is time to take on a policy that is undoubtedly student centric, student is the main stakeholder and that efforts must be taken to make the system respond to their dreams and aspirations. In this line of thinking this best practice gives the acceptability of many modes of learning including that of face to face learning, online learning and virtual mode.

The outcome of this blended learning is heightened teacher and student interface, time management and flexibility in teaching and learning milieu. augmented erudition skills, better access to info, enhanced gratification and learning outcomes, and prospects both to learn with others and to teach others. Teachers are more of a facilitator and learners more self-reliant.

### **Problems Encountered and Resources Required**

Lack of regular connectivity and low bandwidth in remote and rural areas. A big constraining factor has been the financial status of rural students and availability of smart mobile phones/data with them. Some students shared their smartphones with their siblings as all were taking online classes. Background noise created frequent disruptions. ICT enabled devices were updated with Wi-Fi in each block. Some faculty members took time to get in tune with the latest teaching method and were effectively encouraged by the younger employees.

#### Resources

Strong internet connection, Wi-Fi, technical support for smart classrooms. Not all digital resources are dependable and easy to use. Problems are solved with co-operation of staff and students by providing suitable slots at the Network Resource Centre.

### **Notes (Optional)**

Role of teachers is more as facilitators. Students used to complete assignments online and then come to class for discussions. Teachers used rotational model, sometimes difficult topics were given to students to study on their own, then discussed online and students shared their knowledge. Later on offline sessions addressed personal problems of slow learners. Students attended lectures, accessed course content, asked questions, and even finished their assignments online. A lot of flexibility was seen in blended teaching and learning method. Most of the classrooms (B-2, B-3, P-9, H-6, H-7, H-9, Virtual Classroom, Multipurpose Hall, and Conference Hall) have facility of computer, podium, screen, and projector.


#### पर्यावरण हमारे जीवन से जुड़ा हुआ है
