O.N. SRIVASTAVA PRATIBHA SAMMAN SCHOLARSHIP

Objective

Selection of two meritorious students every year, one each from Arts and Commerce Faculties of Hamidia College, who have completed graduation and pursuing post-graduation here.

Institution of the Scholarship

Govt Hamidia Arts and Commerce College is proud to have among its alumni several luminaries who became leaders in their respective fields. One such eminent ex-student of the college is Sri ON Srivastava (1946-48 Batch), who studied at this college, became an Indian Administrative Service officer and rose to become Governor of the states of Manipur and Nagaland.

Sri O N Srivastava, in the year 1996 (the Golden Jubilee Year), initially donated a sum of Rs 1 lakh to the college for the award of two scholarships, one each for meritorious PG first year students of Arts and Commerce.

The amount of fellowship

The entire donation received is deposited with the Bank of Baroda, Bhopal in fixed deposit and the interest earned thereon is rounded off to nearest thousand rupees for disbursement of scholarship for a particular year. The balance amount (Principal) is retained in the fixed deposit to be utilised for disbursement of scholarship in subsequent years. The amount of scholarship is given as onetime payment for the entire year (first year of PG).

Eligibility criteria

- Only regular students of Hamidia college who pursue their post-graduation also from this college are eligible. Any breaks in study are not acceptable.
- Students completing the entire graduation course without any break, with minimum 60% marks in all the six semesters.
 - (Or, 60% marks in the annual examinations in the all the three years at graduation level.)
- The applicant should be a regular student of PG in the college and not availing any other merit-based scholarship.
- Weightage of different achievements -
 - 80% for academic achievements,

20% for other activities (NCC - 7 %; NSS -3%; Sports - 5%; cultural activities - 5%

The Committee

- Scholarship is awarded on the recommendation of a committee constituted for this purpose.
- It consists of one senior Professor, one Assistant Professor and one non-teaching staff as members. One college alumnus is also nominated in the committee.

Procedure

- Meeting of *Pratibha Samman* Scholarship Committee is held during the first week of August every year.
- Applications are invited from eligible PG students in the prescribed form, through due publication of notice.
- The committee scrutinizes all the applications and makes its recommendation to the principal.
- Disbursement of scholarship is made through cheque.
