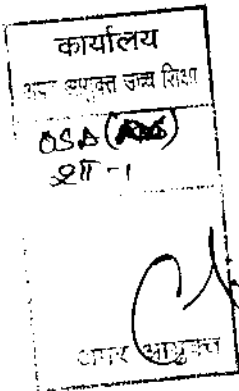

signed a Memorandum of Cooperation (MoC) on a Basic Framework for partnership for
employment opportunities in Japan for "Specified Skilled Workers (SSW)" on 18th January
2021. Further India-Japan Joint Working Group (JWG) meeting was held on 08 February 2021,
which focused on early implementation of the MoC.

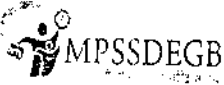
Specified Skilled Worker (SSW) is a new status of residence created by Japan in 2019 under
which skilled Indian nationals can obtain jobs and stay in Japan. The MoC covers 14
categories of specified skills under which skilled workers from India would be eligible for
employment in Japan. List of the 14 categories, which are basically sectors of employment, is
given on page 01 of the annexure.

Eligibility requirements for SSW Status are-

- Qualify Japanese Language skill test and
- Qualify work skills test. Japanese-Language Proficiency Test is a standardized criterion-referenced test to assess, verify, and confirm the ability of the Japanese language of non-native speakers and Japanese learners. Dear Chief Secretary

India and Japan signed a Memorandum of Cooperation (MOC) on a Basic Framework for partnership for employment opportunities in Japan for "Specified Skilled Worker" (SSW), on 18 January 2021. Soon thereafter, the first meeting of the India-Japan Joint Working Group (JWG) on Specified Skilled Workers was held virtually, on 8 February 2021, which stressed early implementation of the MOC.

2. The MOC covers 14 categories of specified skills under which skilled workers from India would be eligible for employment in Japan including inter alia healthcare, construction, agriculture. Japan would grant these workers the status of a Specified Skilled Worker following a qualifying Japanese language test and work skill test.

3. In 2018, Japan projected 3,50,000 vacancies across the 14 sectors for five years (until 2023); demand is expected to continue.

4. To be eligible for the SSW category, an interested Indian national has to qualify in a Japanese language test and work skill test as prescribed by the Japanese organizations. A detailed note on the SSW scheme is enclosed. This has information on the Special Skills included in the MOC and details of the content of the examination, requirements for the language tests and work skill tests.

5. It is requested that you may share the information with relevant stakeholders in your State, provide publicity to the scheme and train people for the mutually agreed sectoral skills. The list of training institutions currently available in the State may be shared with us.

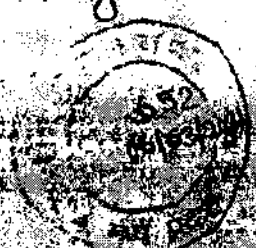

It covers Japanese language knowledge, reading comprehension, and listening skills. In Japan, It has been administered by the JEES (Japan Educational Exchanges and Services), while the J.F. (Japan Foundation) <https://www.jpf.go.jp/e/administers> overseas tests.
