- ➤ Matdata Jagrukta Abhiyan Students together with NSS Volunteers participated in many competitions to create awareness for Voters. Slogan writing, essay competitions were organised.
- ➤ Voter Awareness Drive programme for creating awareness of voting rights as part of the Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) programme. Students informed the public about voting rights through social media and nukkad nataks.
- ➤ Respect for National Flag and National Anthem Hamidia College organizes activities that reinforce constitutional values, rights, duties and responsibilities of students. The Constitution of India designates high values and responsibilities on citizens viz. respect for the National Flag and the National Anthem, uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of the country. These objectives are in the focus of Hamidia College as the vision and the mission statements emphasize. Every year Hamidia College celebrates Republic Day and Independence Day with hoisting of National flag, singing of National Anthem and devotional songs, taking of oath of national integrity.
- Constitution Day is celebrated on 26th November every year with sensitization of students on responsibility towards the constitutional values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens. Students are inspired



to contribute in activities on the related themes.

- National Voters Day is celebrated, and campaigns taken by the students make them aware towards their democratic rights and duties.
- At UG level, curriculum in Foundation Course deals with environmental issues to sensitize students for preserving ecosystem and environment. The students learn about moral values through Mahatma Gandhi's "My Experiments with Truth." They also learn about rights and duties, liberty and equality, justice, welfare state, power and authority, Indian National Movement, Fundamental Rights and Duties, etc.
- ➤ Gandhi Jayanti, Vivekananda Jayanti, Teacher's Day, National Unity Day, are celebrated to inculcate moral values and respect for elders and fellow beings.
- ➤ Blood donation drives and road safety rallies infuse sense of pride, compassion, and responsibility towards the nation. Volunteering in national health programme, in association with Government and Nongovernment organizations has created a niche for the students at the college.
