Dear Prashant Chauhan,

I am directed to refer to this Office Letter No. 2-55/2022-Estt./13689, dated 18.07.2024 on the subject provided therein and to say that the Director, Zoological Survey of India is pleased to offer you the appointment to the post of Photographer Grade III, on purely temporary basis, at Southern Regional Centre, Zoological Survey of India, 130 Santhome High Road, Chennai, Tamilnadu, Pin Code- 600 028 on the following terms and conditions:

- i. The post is Non-Ministerial (Non-Gazetted) and carries the pay in Level-4 in the Pay Matrix (Rs. 25500-81100/-). If you are already in Government Service, your pay will be fixed in the above Level in accordance with the rules and conditions prevailing at the time. If you are not a Government Servant, you will be entitled to the minimum of the pay in the Level-4 of the post. Dearness Allowances and other allowances will be admissible under the rules governing the grant of such allowances in force.
- ii. Your appointment is provisional but likely to be confirmed subject to the verification of your character and antecedents. In case, any of the information is found incorrect, or in case, the verification confirms that the facts given by you in your self-declaration were not correct, this appointment letter, forthwith, shall be cancelled. As a consequence, you will be rendered unfit for any Government Employment and will be liable to undertake other criminal/civil/legal action as per provision of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), etc. as deemed fit.
- iii. Further, you will be on probation for two years from the date of appointment, which period may be extended at the discretion of the competent authority. On completion of probationary period satisfactorily, you will be considered for confirmation in the said post.

- iv. The appointment will be terminable on one month's notice from either side in accordance with the Central Civil Service (Temporary Service) Rules, 1965 without assigning any reasons. The appointing authority, however, reserves the right of terminating the service forthwith or before the expiration of the stipulated period of notice by making payment to him of a sum equivalent to the pay and allowances for the period of notice or the unexpired portion thereof.
