
Objective:


- 1. Meals were successfully arranged for the beneficiaries, addressing their immediate needs.



- 4. The event was well-received by the community, inspiring further initiatives to promote humanistic and environmental values.










Bus service at Govt. Hamidia Arts and Commerce College

- 3. To encourage discussions on building resilience and seeking timely help.


Relevance:




Outcome:


